

ACT 250 NOTICE
MINOR APPLICATION #9A0303-2
10 V.S.A. §§ 6001 - 6111

A. Johnson Company has filed application #9A0303-2 for a project generally described as (1) construction of a $\pm 1,150$ square-foot new industrial process kiln building and ± 300 square-foot control room adjacent to the existing kiln building and (2) a ± 0.40 -acre expansion of the existing parking area adjacent to the band mill building. The project is located at 106 Andrew Johnson Drive in Bristol, Vermont. No hearing will be held, and a permit will be issued unless, on or before Wednesday, August 30, 2023, at 4:30 PM, a party notifies the District 9 Commission in writing of an issue requiring a hearing, or the Commission sets the matter for a hearing on its own motion. Any person as defined in 10 V.S.A. § 6085(c)(1) may request a hearing. Any hearing request must be in writing, must state the criteria or sub-criteria at issue, why a hearing is required, and what additional evidence will be presented at the hearing. Any hearing request by an adjoining property owner or other person eligible for party status under 10 V.S.A. § 6085(c)(1)(E) must include a petition for party status under the Act 250 Rules. Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law may not be prepared unless the Commission holds a public hearing.
