

TOWN OF BRISTOL HEARING NOTICE - APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF DOWNTOWN DESIGNATION

The Bristol Selectboard hereby gives notice of their intent to submit the Town of Bristol's application for renewal of its official downtown designation under the State of Vermont's Downtown Program. The Selectboard will hold a public hearing to discuss the application at its meeting on Monday, June 10, 2024, at the Town Office located at the lower level of Holley Hall. The meeting begins at 7:00pm and this will be among the early items on the agenda. This will be a hybrid in-person meeting as well as conducted through Zoom. People without a computer or other device can call in from the number below and enter the meeting ID from the phone keypad.

Bristol has had an official designated downtown under the State program for eighteen years and is seeking renewal under the program for an additional eight years. The purpose of the meeting will be to receive comments from the public about the program, about Bristol's downtown, and to share information about the program and its benefits.
