

**ACT 250 NOTICE**  
**MINOR APPLICATION #9A0325-4**  
**10 V.S.A. §§ 6000 - 6111**

The Keewaydin Foundation, Songadeewin of Keewaydin, has filed application #9A0325-4 for a project generally described as construction of a new gravel parking area adjacent to the existing equipment cabin to accommodate vans and canoe trailers. The project is located at 500 Rustic Lane in Salisbury, Vermont. The application may be viewed on the Land Use Review Board's Act 250 Database (<https://anrweb.vt.gov/ANR/Act250/default.aspx>) by entering project number "9A0325-4."

No hearing will be held, and a permit may be issued unless, on or before Wednesday, April 30, 2025, at 4:30 PM, a party notifies the District 9 Commission in writing of an issue requiring a hearing, or the Commission sets the matter for a hearing on its own motion. Any person as defined in 10 V.S.A. § 6085(c)(1) may request a hearing. Any hearing request must be in writing, must state the criteria or sub-criteria at issue, why a hearing is required, and what additional evidence will be presented at the hearing. Any hearing request by an adjoining property owner or other person eligible for party status under 10 V.S.A. § 6085(c)(1)(E) must include a petition for party status under the Act 250 Rules.
