The Town of Bristol and VHB invite all residents, business owners, and interested parties to join a Local Concerns Meeting to discuss the West Street Sidewalk Improvement Scoping Study in our community. The South side of West Street has some existing sidewalks of varying conditions and many areas without any sidewalks. The project area is between Holley Hall and 49 West Street (Village Creemee Stand). The inconsistent sidewalk infrastructure poses a risk to pedestrian safety and limits connectivity within the downtown area.

Funded through a VTrans Bicycle and Pedestrian Program grant, the Town has hired the multidisciplinary engineering and design firm VHB to evaluate the project area and develop cost-effective solutions that would improve the accessibility and safety in this sidewalk corridor.

This Local Concerns meeting is an opportunity for the public to learn more about the project and to share any information, concerns, and ideas. VHB will be giving a presentation during the Selectboard meeting regarding the project. The intent of this meeting is to gather community input that will shape and help define the purpose and needs of this project.

The meeting will be part of the Selectboard's regular meeting agenda. The meeting begins at 7:00pm with this presentation following preliminary agenda items.
