

ACT 250 NOTICE
MINOR APPLICATION #9A0190-4
10 V.S.A. §§ 6000 - 6111

The President & Fellows of Middlebury College have filed application #9A0190-4 for a project generally described as improvements at the Middlebury College athletic facilities as follows: (1) installation of four, ninety-foot lighting poles and associated infrastructure at Youngman Field and (2) installation of a new press box and scoreboard at the South Street soccer field. No changes to existing uses are proposed or authorized. The Project is located at 14 Old Chapel Road and 162 Porter Field Road in Middlebury, Vermont. The application may be viewed on the Land Use Review Board's Act 250 Database (<https://anrweb.vt.gov/ANR/Act250/default.aspx>) by entering project number "9A0190-4."

No hearing will be held, and a permit may be issued unless, on or before Wednesday, April 1, 2026, a party notifies the District 9 Commission in writing of an issue requiring a hearing, or the Commission sets the matter for a hearing on its own motion. Any person as defined in 10 V.S.A. § 6085(c)(1) may request a hearing. Any hearing request must be in writing, must state the criteria or sub-criteria at issue, why a hearing is required, and what additional evidence will be presented at the hearing. Any hearing request by an adjoining property owner or other person eligible for party status under 10 V.S.A. § 6085(c)(1)(E) must include a petition for party status under the Act 250 Rules. Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law may not be prepared unless the Commission holds a public hearing.
