

LEMON FAIR INSECT CONTROL DISTRICT PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO APPLY MOSQUITO LARVICIDES

The Lemon Fair Insect Control District may be making ground and aerial applications of *Bacillus thuringiensis israelensis* (BTI), *Bacillus sphaericus* (BS), spinosad and (S)-Methoprene to surface waters where mosquito larvae are present. These applications will occur in the towns of Cornwall, Bridport, and Weybridge. Pesticide applications will begin on or after April 15, 2026. A permit to conduct mosquito larvicide applications has been requested from the Vermont Agency of Agriculture, Food and Markets.
