

ACT 250 NOTICE
MINOR APPLICATION #9A0312-4
10 V.S.A. §§ 6000 - 6111

Addison County Solid Waste Management District has filed application #9A0312-4, deemed complete on April 15, 2026, for a project generally described as (1) construction of a ±310 square foot attendant building within "Phase 2" of the existing ACSWMD transfer station facility upon Lot 6 of the Norris Subdivision; and (2) expansion of existing ACSWMD operations onto an adjacent ±2.0-acre lot. The expansion aspect of the project includes demolition of an existing structure on the "Church Lot" and construction of a new ±3,250 square foot Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) facility with associated access drive, parking, and stormwater improvements. The project will be served by an on-site drilled well and an existing community mound wastewater disposal system. The project is located at 65 & 145 Campground Road in New Haven, Vermont. The application may be viewed on the Land Use Review Board's Act 250 Database (<https://anrweb.vt.gov/ANR/Act250/default.aspx>) by entering project number "9A0312-4."

No hearing will be held, and a permit may be issued unless, on or before May 13, 2026, a party notifies the District 9 Commission in writing of an issue requiring a hearing, or the Commission sets the matter for a hearing on its own motion. Any person as defined in 10 V.S.A. § 6085(c)(1) may request a hearing. Any hearing request must be in writing, must state the criteria or sub-criteria at issue, why a hearing is required, and what additional evidence will be presented at the hearing. Any hearing request by an adjoining property owner or other person eligible for party status under 10 V.S.A. § 6085(c)(1)(E) must include a petition for party status under the Act 250 Rules. Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law may not be prepared unless the Commission holds a public hearing.
