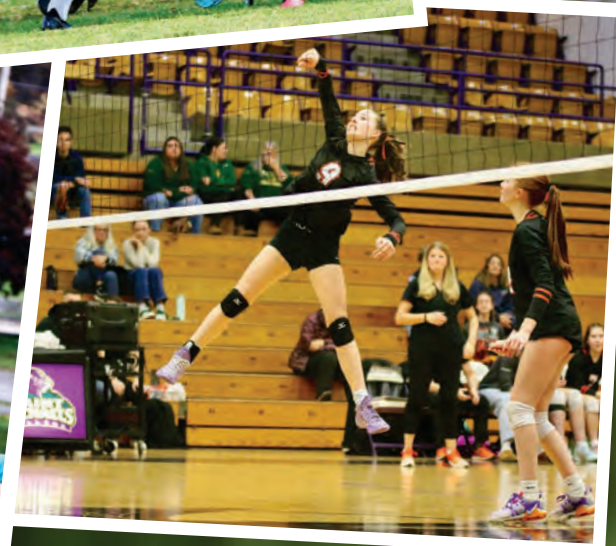

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Fall 2026 teams defending titles and aiming for more wins

ADDISON COUNTY — Summer 2025 must have been restorative for local athletes — three teams started the school year as returning state champions.

With other teams having gotten close to the finals last fall, 2026 is sure to be an exciting autumn.

Only a few games into their seasons, teams are showing promise.

Just to highlight some of the exciting

prospects, after winning the 2025 state championship, the enthusiastic Middlebury Union High School volleyball team hasn't missed a beat — they continued a multi-game winning streak from last year with their first two games of 2026.

For any soccer fans, the VUHS pitch is the place to be. The defending state championship girls' team looked strong in its season-opener.

And the Commodore boys' soccer team is coming off a winning season.

Only four teams were able to defeat them across the 16 games they played.

With numerous varsity players returning, the momentum of a big 2025 campaign and plenty of motivation all on their side, Mount Abraham Union High School teams have the makings of successful seasons this fall, too.

The 2025 Division-III No. 2 seed Eagle field hockey team returns numerous players, and is getting lots of younger athletes their start; Eagle football could

rise to the top if they have another season like last; and early in the year the volleyball team, which just started its second season ever, scored a promising 3-0 victory.

FOOTBALL

The MUHS football team capped its 2025 season with the Division-I crown in a 13-7 victory over St. Johnsbury. It was the 15th time a Tiger team, which got the No. 1 seed in 2025, has finished at the top of the charts.

In the 11 games MUHS played last fall, only once was a team able to defeat them.

Last year's roster included 12 seniors. Though the team loses a wealth of experience this season, it also has a robust class of incoming seniors and juniors — nine and 10, respectively. That includes last year's starting quarterback, senior Brady Lloyd.

He is joined by classmates Jason Sperry, Parker Carl, Rudy Devold, Tucker Wright, Connor Swan, Sam Sherman, Aiden Arsenault and Rowdy Malcolm for their final high school season.

In addition to Malcolm, the new faces on the 30-person roster are juniors Larry Bougor III and Evan Northrup, plus sophomores Jerry Nop, Watson Malcolm, Teddy Curran, Ryan Rheume, Lucas Wing, Ezra Bliven, Kieran King and Tucker Sheldrick.

With Coach Jed Malcolm at the helm for another season, the 2026 Tigers hit the road for their eight-game regular season on Sept. 5 against Burr & Burton Academy.

Their home-opener, scheduled for Sept. 18 at 7 p.m., will be a repeat of the 2025 state championship — St. Johnsbury is due in Middlebury that night.

GIRLS' SOCCER

Coach Reeves Livesay's Tiger girls' soccer team is flush with returning varsity players after rebuilding in 2025.

Of the 13 who return from last year's team, which went 1-13-1, five are seniors — Isabel Quinn (midfield), Emilia Bullock (forward), Jordyn Rushton (forward), Evelyn Schoelzel (midfield) and Alice Livesay

(midfield).

Making their varsity debuts will be junior Kiera Sell (defense), sophomores Josephine Ives (forward), Celia Fallis (midfield), Emma Quinn (defense) and Penny Lickun (goalie), and freshman Nicola Power (forward).

BOYS' SOCCER

The MUHS boys' soccer team opened 2026 with a 1-0 win over VUHS. That Sept. 1 game was the first of four away games before the team plays at home for the first time on Thursday, Sept. 17, against Winooski.

The 2025 Tigers went 5-10 and graduated a class of 10 seniors.

This year's 19-person roster, coached by Oscar Loomis, features another large class of eight 12-graders — Annan Duquette-Hoffman (defense), Micah McConnell (midfield), Timmy Laframboise (forward), Landon Hunt (forward), Porter McDonnell (midfield), Henry McDonnell (defender), Noah Gillespie (midfield) and Judah Matovu (forward).

New varsity players are junior defenders Miles Goetz and Nathan Anderson, sophomores Brady Duguay (defense), Arthur Calvi (forward) and Hartley Littlefield (midfield), and freshmen Eric Chen (goalie), Julian Palcsik (defense) and Oscar Linn (forward).

CROSS COUNTRY

The highlight of last year's cross country season was the Tiger girls' third place D-II finish at the state meet. At the top for MUHS was Louisa Orten, who finished 10th as a sophomore.

Between the boys' and girls' sides, the freshman class accounts for 15 of the 31-member team.

There are no senior girls on the team this year. In addition to Sadie Chance (junior) and Mia Rosen (sophomore), new to

the girls' roster are freshmen Cady Baker-Rouse, Rosie Barry, Genevieve Cammack, Evelyn Fuller, Sedsel Gillette, Talulah Nurok, Sydney Safran and Autumn Spritzer.

The boys' roster includes seniors Blake Davidson, Charlie Reiderer, Jase Kozak,

Truth Fetterolf and newcomer Nate Cooke Yoder.

Also new this year are freshmen Nathaniel Boulanger, Erik Bruning, Welly Hescok, Finn Ray, Henry Schmitt, Beowulf Yarbrough and Elke Yarbrough.

VOLLEYBALL

Coach Bethany Morrissey's D-II state champion Tiger volleyball team graduated seven seniors last spring, but returned another big class of 12-graders for what will be its fifth year as a program.

This year's seniors — many of whom helped the 2025 team to the title, a 16-1 record and the No. 1 playoff seed — are Kate Kozak, Julia Morrissey, Tenny Laroche, Addie Young, Ida Blackwell and Gabby Araujo.

In addition to Araujo, newly serving, setting and bumping on the 16-person varsity squad are juniors Thea Porter and Maya Jacobs, plus sophomores Avery Thompson, Kali Lenihan, Morgan McNulty and Millie Tenny.

Additionally, the team fielded enough athletes for junior varsity A and B teams.

FIELD HOCKEY

The Tiger field hockey team has just one senior — Heaven Bergeron, the team's goalie, who had 16 saves in the team's opener against Fair Haven on Sept. 1.

The largest class on Coach MaKayla Broughton's team, which went 2-11-1 last year, is freshman — Marleigh Vose (midfield), Annie Hackett (defense/midfield), Ashling Gervaise (forward/midfield), Eleanor O'Leary (forward/midfield), June Austin (forward), Kinsley Doherty (defense), Tenley Chittenden (forward/midfield), Isabel Jones (forward/midfield), Myla Thompson (forward/midfield), Deborah Sherry (forward/midfield), Piper Jacobs (defense/midfield) and Grace Martin (defense).

The 12 ninth-graders also make up all of this year's new players.

GOLF

The golf team, which had no seniors last year, has a large class of nine coming up — Taylor Altemose, Max Ayer, Ryan Brouillard, Conner Gordon, James Hellyer, Rowdy Malcolm, Reaney McKinley, Maggie Morter and Abigail Andres. All are returners except for Andres.

Juniors Liam McDonald and Maya Jacobs, and sophomore Watson Malcom are also new to the team.

BASS FISHING

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Early wins and strong rosters for the Eagles as fall sports begin

GIRLS' SOCCER

The 2026 Mt. Abe girls' soccer roster, which is void of five seniors from 2025 who graduated in the spring, is small — they have just three subs.

Coach Dustin Corrigan's returning 12, who helped the team to a 7-6-2 record in 2025, will be grateful for the additions of junior Mattea O'Bryan, a defender, and sophomore Delia Park, a forward.

Eleven of the 14 are upperclassmen. Five are seniors back for their final seasons — Leah Tierney (forward), Thompson Davis (midfielder), Raquel Harris (defender/midfielder), Brooke Barnard (defender) and Aubrey Coffey (defender).

The team, which competes in Division II, began the season with two victories during their first week of competition — a 2-0 win against Fair Haven on Aug. 28 and a 2-1 win over U-32 on Sept. 2.

BOYS' SOCCER

Last year's upperclassmen-heavy Eagle boys' soccer team earned the top D-II seed and made it all the way to the final against Milton, losing out on a title by just one overtime goal. The final score was 1-0, and that game brought Mt. Abe's season record to 15-2-1.

Seven seniors from Coach Chris Coffey's 2025 team graduated in spring, leaving room for a number of new faces on the 2026 roster, which came to 19 members after tryouts.

Filling the spots left by graduates are seniors Baxter Montgomery (defense) and Lincoln Painter (defense), juniors Quinn Kirshenbaum (defense), Luke Goodfellow (midfield), Sam Galivan (forward), Beckett Stillwell (defense), Noah Germon (midfield/forward), Jarrett Sturtevant (defense) and Keller Obariski (goalie), and sophomore Levi Clark (midfield).

The team's two freshmen are Miko Lazare and Finn McCarthy. Both are midfielders.

The returning seniors on the team are Sean Golden (forward), Kestrel Edwards (defense/midfield), Abraham Camara (midfield/forward), Truman Sawyer (defense), Jaran Griffin (forward) and Rowan Clark (defense).

With games just having recently started, the team was finding their footing during their first two, which they lost by close margins. The Eagles' opener, played against VUHS, ended 1-0, and their second game, against Rice, 3-2.

FOOTBALL

Coach Jeff Stein's combined Mount Abraham/Vergennes football program

grew by two members in the past year — from 26 to 28 — and features 17 new faces, plus 11 returners. The team lost that many to graduation in the spring.

This MAV football team enters 2026 with the momentum of last season, which was the best of any Eagle team in over 20 years.

The team went 8-2, earned the No. 3 seed in D-III and reached the semifinals, where they exited in a 44-14 loss to No. 2 Bellows Falls.

FIELD HOCKEY

The D-III Eagle field hockey team enters 2026 coming off a 10-5 season in which they earned the second playoff seed.

While last year's post-season run ended in the quarterfinals, Coach Jen Myers's team went out fighting. The game against Stowe, the No. 7 seed, was a hard fought double overtime nailbiter, that ended in a 1-0 loss for the Eagles.

Though the young team returns just two seniors — midfielder Natalie Smith and defender Lux Tierney — over half the roster has experience at the varsity level, including sophomore goalie Jillian Cousino, who started in net freshman year.

Besides the seniors, the 21-member team is comprised of seven juniors, five sophomores and seven freshmen.

Marking their varsity debuts are juniors Binti Bangoura (defense) and Callie Rule (forward).

Also joining the varsity team for the first time is a large freshman class — Emma Rule (defense), Violet Lenihan (forward), Lydia Paquette (forward/midfield), Kennedy Courtemanche (midfield), Haylee LaFreniere (midfield/defense), Raein Rochon (midfield) and Heaven Audy (goalie).

CROSS COUNTRY

Eagle cross country coaches Tucker Anderson and Katie Burdett have 10 runners to wrangle this season.

New to the team are freshman Iris Bassett and Noa Tzuriel. All others are returning, including seniors Bennett Eberhardy and Oliver Zelonis.

GOLF

This fall 11 Eagle golfers will hit the fairways and green.

The seniors are Cameron Castillo, Jackson LaMarche, Irie Mazur and Abraham Ready.

In addition to Mazur and Ready, Lincoln McGrath (junior), Otto Sigfried (junior) and Forest Turner (sophomore) are additions to the 2026 roster.

VOLLEYBALL

After its inaugural season, which ended with 5 wins and 10 losses, the Mt. Abe volleyball program is back with a year under its belt.

The eight-person squad includes just one senior, Gemma Lyles. New to the

team this year are junior Cora Conrad and sophomore Abi Sykes.

Coach Breanna Sykes noted that with few subs, her team is working hard on the court during games.

Despite their small numbers, the team swept Missisquoi on the road during their second game of the year. The Eagles were 1-1 after that.

BASS FISHING

Last year's four Mt. Abe bass fishers are back for their final season. Ethan Bromley, Garrett Duell, and 2024 state champions Hailey and Isayah Isham, will spend one more fall together, led by Coach Carroll Isham.

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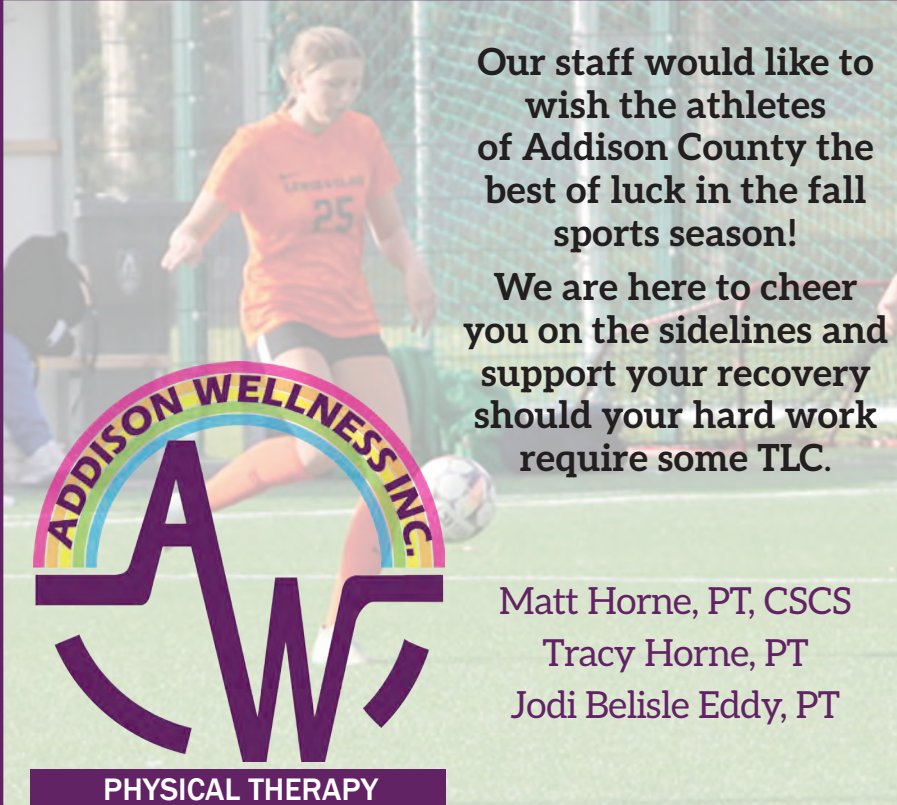
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VUHS soccer shows promise in first games, other teams look strong

GIRLS' SOCCER

The peak of last fall for Vergennes Union High School sports was the Division III girls' soccer final.

The 2025 Commodores, seeded second in the state tournament, were crowned victors after defeating Peoples Academy, 2-0, in the final match of the season. They stomached just a single loss across 18 games.

The first time the team set foot on the field since then, at home on Aug. 29, they came away with a 1-0 win over Middlebury Union High School.

"They were excited about it and the game looked really good. I think cohesively as a unit, we're sorting it through, we're figuring it out," Coach Morgan Kathan said of her team following their 2026 debut.

"Everybody's doing their part, playing their role, and it's going to be a really great season."

The team, which had just six subs last fall and graduated six seniors this spring, returns 11 with varsity experience. That includes last year's championship win-

ning goalie, then-sophomore Addie Smith.

Kathan, who is in her third year as coach, fielded a roster that's on the smaller side again this year. It's just 16 players.

New additions are junior Lauren Hill, a forward, Ila Borah, a defender, and freshmen Cici Neffinger, Reese Matton and Sophia Buck, a defender and two midfielders, respectively.

The senior class includes five of last year's state champions — midfielders Eva Borah, Megan Willis and Isabelle Van Voorst, and defenders Ella Romond and Adrienne Smits.

When asked about goals for this season Kathan said, "I think our biggest goal is to make this team as strong as it possibly can, and hope to see ourselves at the end. We'd love to be playing Nov. 1 at Rutland. We'd love to do that, and I think that's always everybody's goal, right?"

"But I think for us realistically, it's to pay attention to the season right now, strengthen ourselves early, and then have

a great playoff run."

BOYS' SOCCER

Like the girls' side, the Commodore boys' soccer team has a tight 15-person roster.

That group includes returning seniors Colton Reed (goalie), Jude Bragg (forward), Elliot Cosgrove (forward) and Connor Simison (defense).

This year's additions are juniors Cyrus Clair (midfield) and Marwan Liebhaber (defense), sophomores Spencer Short-sleeve (midfield), Henry Stroup (defense), Tucker Couture (defense) and Andrew Houghton (forward), and freshmen Cooper Reed (midfield) and Conrad Cameron (midfield).

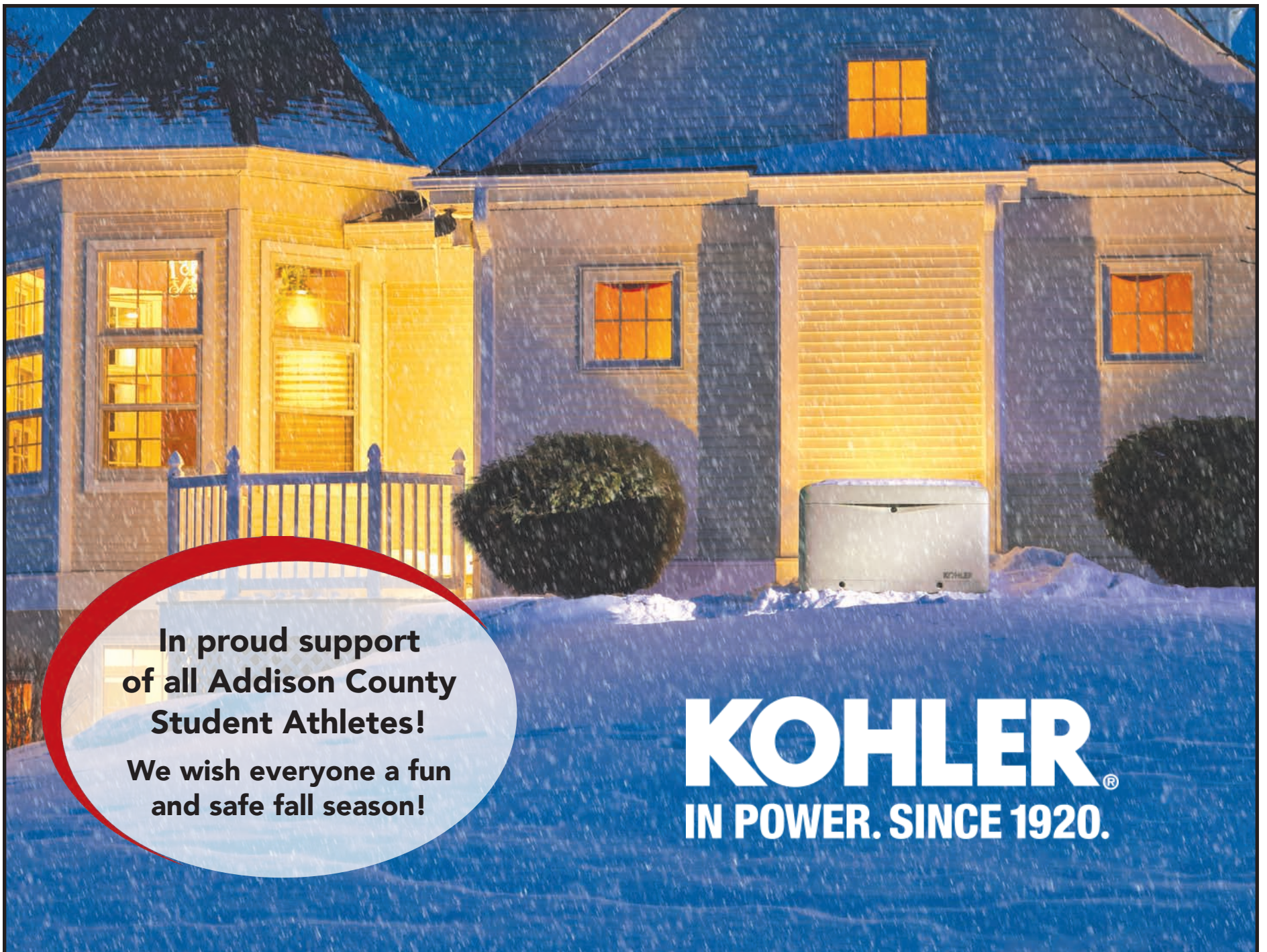
